

Performances for Young People Ticket Policies

Thank you for your interest in UGA's Piedmont Athens Regional Performing Arts Center's Performances for Young People program. This program is designed to expose students in grades K-12 to the performing arts by facilitating in-person, educational, arts experiences. The program's purpose is to inspire the next generation of artists and arts supporters. The costs of these performances are generously subsidized by supporters of this program who share that vision. Parents and guardians are encouraged to exercise personal judgment when determining if programs are appropriate for their children.

Admission is **\$6** each for students and adult chaperones. Students must be at least six years old to attend (unless noted for specific events). Parents, guardians, and teachers should exercise personal judgement when determining if programs are appropriate for their children and students.

Large school groups - please use the registration form found on the UGA PAC website for reservations or contact the Performing Arts Center's outreach coordinator by emailing PACoutreach@uga.edu. Reservations are not guaranteed until confirmed by the Outreach Coordinator.

Home school groups - ***New for the 2026-27 season***, all home school tickets will be sold **online** only. Beginning August 5, tickets can be purchased online at <https://pac.uga.edu/organizer/performances-for-young-people/>. Tickets will **not** be sold in person or by telephone. Limit six tickets per event per household. Mobile tickets will be sent to purchasers via email and will be scanned at the doors for entry to the performances.

Reservations for performances in the 2026-2027 season begin **August 5, 2026**.

Home school Ticketing Policies

1. In order to allow as many individual home school groups as possible the opportunity to participate, each group is limited to **6** tickets per performance. Each purchase must be linked to the account of a unique individual adult chaperone with valid contact information. Multiple accounts may not be used to exceed ticket limits for the same group or affiliated groups. We reserve the right to cancel any orders and prohibit future participation for groups who exceed, or attempt to exceed, established ticket limits, including orders associated with the same name, e-mail address, billing address, credit card number, group name, or other identifiable information.
2. In order to accommodate as many students as possible, we encourage one adult chaperone to attend per group. However, in cases where more than one chaperone is needed, please note that a maximum of **one adult chaperone per student** is allowed. This will be enforced when purchasing online as well as when entering the venue for performances. Performances for Young People are designed specifically for students K-12, and should not be considered a substitute for attending a regular public performance as a family or other non-student group.

3. Mobile tickets will be sent to purchasers via email approx a week before each performance. All sales are final—no refunds or cancellations. However, you will be sent a event reminder email one week prior to the event with instructions for how to transfer tickets to someone else if you are unable to attend.
4. Tickets will be scanned at the doors for entry to all performances and everyone in your group must have a valid ticket. **Purchased tickets will only guarantee seating/entry until 10 minutes before performance start time.** After that time, seats will be given to anyone waiting standby. Refunds will not be given for late or absent patrons. Please plan to arrive at least 20-30 minutes before the scheduled performance start time.
5. Due to limited capacity in the venues, we regularly turn away many groups who wish to attend because capacity has been reached. Because of this, groups who purchase tickets that are not utilized may be restricted from future participation.
